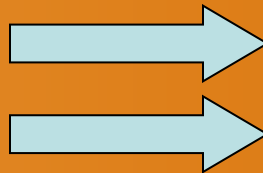

Erasmus Mundus (EMA2) Triple I is consortium of 20 higher education institutions located in Europe and in Russian Federation. The project promotes institutional development in field of international cooperation and internationalization of partner universities by awarding grants for students, researchers, teachers and other staff. Study and research opportunities are given to European applicants to Russian Partner Universities and citizens of Russian Federation to European Partner Universities. Mobility scheme is open to undergraduate, master, doctorate, post-doctorate and staff applicants. Why apply to Triple I read experiences by our alumni, [here](#).

Triple I opens call for applications on 24 October 2011 until 14 December 2011, 2 p.m. (Finnish time). All mobilities must start latest by December 2012 and end on 31 May 2015. Purpose of mobility can be non-degree studies (exchange studies) or degree studies (studies leading for degree at Triple I Partner University). Applications are welcomed at all mobility levels from undergraduates to staff applicants.

## Higher Education

EU-Russian activities in the area of education have seen a steady expansion over the past couple of years. The Roadmap for the Fourth Common Space on Research, Education and Culture, agreed at the EU-Russia Summit in Moscow in May, 2005, lays out three main areas for cooperation:

- ▶ Encouraging closer co-operation in the area of non-formal education;
- ▶ Promoting the development of life skills education.
- ▶ Making the European Higher Education Area a reality, in accordance with the principles of the Bologna Process (see below).

These objectives are realised through practical measures and projects including facilitating links between Russian and European universities; encouraging awards of joint or double diplomas; establishing quality monitoring systems for Russian curricula and institutions, as well as internal university quality-control systems; supporting Russian participation in the Erasmus Mundus programme; promoting EU studies in Russia (including training for government officials and post-graduate students and the establishment of the European Studies Institute at MGIMO); and promoting the study of Russia and the Russian language in the EU, as well as the study of the EU and European languages in Russia.

### The Bologna Process

The aim of the Bologna Process is to establish a Europe-wide framework for higher education that will have a real impact on the lives of European citizens: individuals from participating countries will be able to move freely between higher education institutions, jobs, business and countries. It will make students' learning experience more adaptable to changing labour market demands, and increase the competitiveness of higher education systems in the European Higher Education Area. Russia joined the Bologna process in 2003.

The main principles of the [Bologna Declaration](#), as signed by European Education Ministers on 19 June 1999 in Bologna, are to:

- ▶ adopt a coherent system of easily readable and comparable degrees;
- ▶ adopt a system with two main cycles (undergraduate/graduate);
- ▶ establish a system of credits (such as ECTS);
- ▶ overcome obstacles to student/teacher mobility;
- ▶ promote European co-operation in quality assurance.

### How can I get involved?

There are numerous opportunities for Russian professors, bachelor, specialist, master and PhD students and institutions to benefit from the increased EU-Russia cooperation on education. Details of how to participate in current programmes are given below.

### Tempus

Tempus strengthens cooperation in higher education between the European Union and its partner countries from the Western Balkans, Eastern Europe and Central Asia, the Mediterranean region and enhances understanding between cultures. Tempus promotes the "people to people" approach: its added value lies in its promotion of international and regional co-operation, which generates better communication and new networks of personal and professional contacts between the academic worlds of the EU and the partner countries. ### Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters Courses

Russian students having already a higher education degree, be it bachelor, specialist or master degree obtained at a higher education institution licensed by the national authorities, can apply to Erasmus Mundus Masters' Courses to continue their study in Europe to obtain a Master degree from European Universities. Currently, the European Commission is funding more than 100 Erasmus Mundus Masters' Courses and since 2004 more than 240 Russian students have been selected to study on Erasmus Mundus Master's degree programmes in Europe. 70 Russian students have been selected to study on Erasmus Mundus Masters courses from September 2010.
